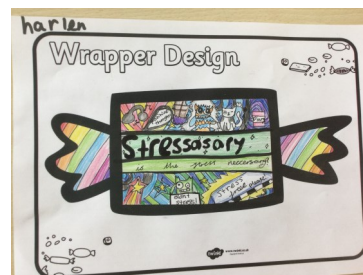
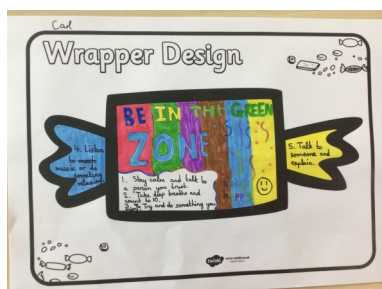

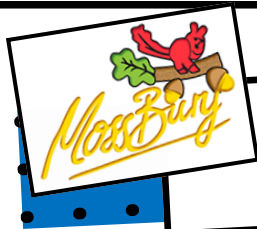

Lucy Andrews - Fundraiser and Gymnast

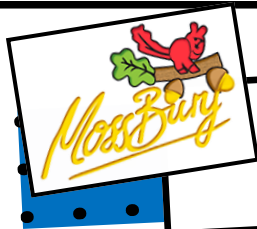
Ama Ofori - Artist
