We hope to see many more children earning their Summer Mossy badge next term.

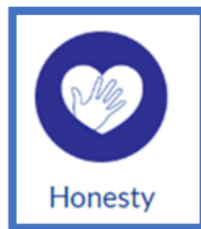
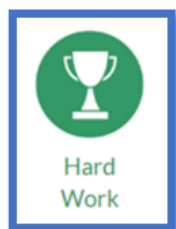


## **A special congratulations....**

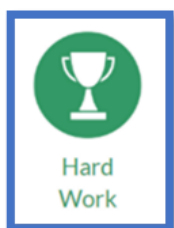

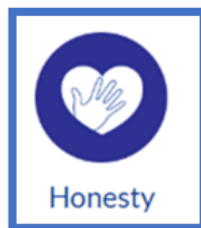
